

Cajun Sweeps ASCS Gulf South Weekend with Win at Battleground Speedway

HIGHLANDS, Texas (August 21, 2010) – Jason Johnson and the JJR #41 team raced for the second night in the row with the ASCS Gulf South Regional Series. Like the first night at Golden Triangle Raceway Park, the Cajun Sensation ended the evening in victory lane in his Weld Racing wheel equipped #41 Maxim at Battleground Speedway. This was only the second time Battleground Speedway hosted the ASCS Gulf South competitors in track history.



After starting the evening from the third starting spot in the second heat race event, Jason raced his way to a solid second place finish behind Gary Watson in the eight lap event at the racy 3/8-mile high banked dirt oval. With his heat race success, Jason would start the feature from the outside of row two in the 4th starting position. At the drop of the green, Michael Dupuy jumped out to the early race lead as Jason maneuvered his #41 into position. Over the first fifteen laps, Johnson stalked Dupuy's #3x around each turn pulling up to his rear bumper and overtaking the lead on the 15th lap of the event. He would not look back, as he accelerated his Don Ott powered Maxim around the oval the last ten laps of the event to capture his fifth ASCS Gulf South series win and JJR's 13th overall victory of the 2010 racing season. Johnson's Haynes Mechanical/Pope Transportation #41 Maxim was chased to the checkered flag by Dupuy, with Channin Tankersley, Ray Allen Kulhanek and Aaron Reutzel rounding out the top five. Tommy Bryant was sixth, with Logan Bledsoe, Greg Rilat, Brandon Berryman and Gary Watson completing the top ten. With his win, Johnson and the JJR #41 team swept this weekend's ASCS Gulf South Region competition.

Jason and the team celebrated their second win of the weekend with sponsor and friend Alan Haynes from Haynes Mechanical. Jason drives the Haynes #47 sprint car over in Australia during the winter break in the states. In victory lane, Jason lamented. "This was a great weekend! Two in a row! These guys race hard and make you work for these wins. This is our second win this weekend and the car was just great each night. The team did a wonderful job getting the car ready."
