

Johnson Earns Podium Spot at I-30 Speedway with 3rd Place Finish

LITTLE ROCK, Arkansas (August 28, 2010) – With a solid run in the Law Offices of Richards Strunks #41, Jason piloted his Maxim to a third place podium finish in the non-stop, 35 lap main event at I-30 Speedway in Little Rock, AR. With his solid third place finish at Little Rock and his ninth place finish at Tri-City Speedway on Friday night, Jason and the JJR #41 team were able to extend their point lead in the ASCS National season long points race.

Jason would line his Don Ott powered #41 on the inside of row two for the first heat event of the evening. Jason would seize the lead and cross the finish line first in the event after a lap four race stoppage for a flipping Jerod Roller coming off turn four. Following Johnson across the line was the #91 of Darren Stewart and the #99 of Brady Bacon. With his heat race victory, Jason and the team would watch the remaining qualifying races intently to see how the track would evolve so they could setup the #41 for the 35 lap feature event at the racy ¼-mile red clay oval.

For the featured event, the #41 would start on the top side of row three from the sixth starting position. Front row starter, Brady Bacon would jump out to an early lead with Tim Crawley, Darren Stewart, and Jason Johnson in constant pursuit. With a slick top side, Jason worked his Maxim patiently around Joe and Tracey Clay's ¼-mile oval looking for opportunities to move forward. Meanwhile, Tim Crawley was pushing the action, and the leader, right in front of Jason. Crawley made a lap 13 pass on Bacon stick and controlled the lead. Behind the leader, Bacon, Darren Stewart, and Johnson were now locked in a fierce battle for the second, third, and fourth positions in the competitive field. On lap 27, Johnson was able to get by Darren Stewart for the third position and quickly started to pressure Brady Bacon for the runner up honors. Over the next eight laps, an intense battle ensued with the Cajun Sensation looking high and then low for an opening to get by the #99 of Bacon. As they made their way around the final circuit at I-30 Speedway, Tim Crawley crossed the line first, followed by Brady Bacon, Jason Johnson, Darren Stewart, with Tony Bruce, Jr. rounding out the top five in the non-stop event. This was Jason's 36th top five finish in the 56 race events he has competed in 2010 (an impressive 64.29% success rate). After the race, Jason commented, "We had a really good night! It was fun racing with those guys tonight." He continued, "I want to thank my team, Richard Strunks (of the Law Offices of Richard Strunks in Fort Smith, AR), and all my sponsorship partners. With their support, we have the opportunity to run up front every time we race."

After a competitive weekend of ASCS National Tour competition at Tri-City Speedway and I-30 Speedway, Jason Johnson and the JJR #41 depart Little Rock with an extended lead in the season long Lucas Oil ASCS National points with 2,281 points. With his runner-up finish, Brady Bacon moves into the second position with 2,209 points (72 points back). Shane Stewart drops back one position to third with 2,191 (90 points back), followed by Jack Dover in fourth with 2,056 points (225 points back), and with his win, Tim Crawley takes over the fifth spot with 2,049 points (232 points back).
